

Resetting the Media Player Region



FOR DVD DISCS

According to the manual, normal DVDs are automatically connected to the correct zone unless the setting has been changed. No resetting should be necessary. However, if the setting has been changed:-

How to change DVD region setting (For BLU-BD3000 player), if necessary.

1. Turn on player but DO NOT INSERT A DISC yet.
2. Click "Setting" in the homepage or press the "Setting" button on the remote control, then;
3. Press "**8520**" to enter the region setting page. Note, there will be no screen prompt telling you to do this - just do it anyway.
4. Change the "DVD Region Code".
 - 3.1. **Global Region:** press "0" (zero) . The player should then automatically select the correct DVD region, or;
 - 3.2. For Australia: press "4", or;**
 - 3.3. **Other:** see table below.
5. Exit the page when finished by pressing the *home key* on the remote.

DVD region codes and geographic scope	
Region code	Area
0	Global
1	United States, Canada, and Bermuda
2	Europe , Greenland, Overseas France, Turkey, Middle East, Egypt, Tunisia, Eswatini, Lesotho, South Africa, and Japan
3	Southeast Asia, South Korea, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and Macau
4	Latin America , Caribbean and Oceania
5	Africa, Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Central Asia, South Asia, Mongolia, and North Korea
6	Mainland China

FOR BLU RAY DISCS

How to change Blu Ray region setting (For BLU-BD3000 player), if necessary.

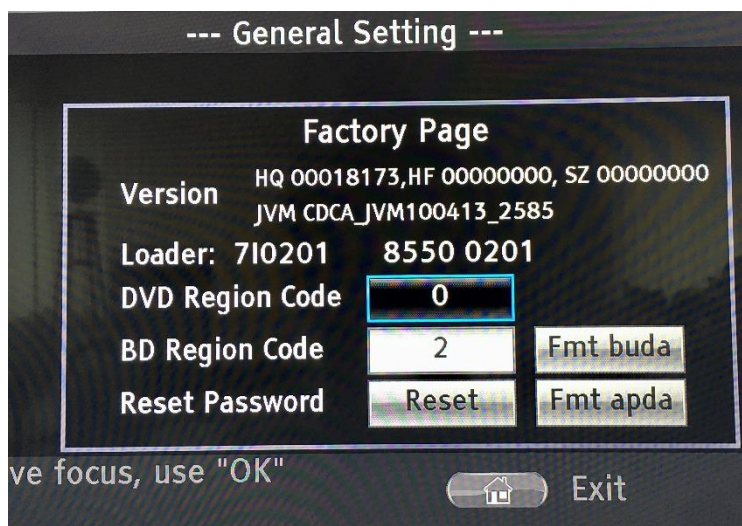
1. Turn on player but DO NOT INSERT A DISC yet.
2. Click "Setting" in the homepage or press the "Setting" button on the remote control, then;
3. Press "8520" to enter the region setting page. Note, there will be no screen prompt telling you to do this - just do it anyway.
4. Change the "BD Region Code".
 - i) **Region A:** press "1" (North America, South America, U.S. Territories, Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, and other areas of Southeast Asia);
 - ii) **Region B: press "2" (Europe, Africa, Middle East, Australia, and New Zealand.)**
 - iii) **Region C:** press "4" (Asia (except for Japan, Korea, Taiwan, and other areas of Southeast Asia))
5. Exit the page when finished.

And most importantly, when you have finished, change the BD Region Code back to Region B (Code #2 – for Australia)

NOTE: The region codes for commercial BD and DVD movies can be found on the back of the case (theoretically!).
