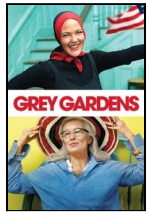

A young teacher inspires her class of at-risk students to learn tolerance, apply themselves and pursue education beyond high school.



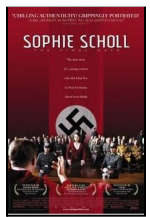

The lives of Edith Bouvier Beale and her daughter Edith, aunt and cousin of Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis.



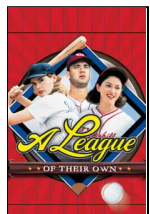

A dramatization of the final days of Sophie Scholl, one of the most famous members of the German World War II anti-Nazi resistance movement, The White Rose.



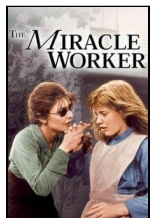

The true story of two sisters who join the first female professional baseball league and struggle to help it succeed amidst their own growing rivalry.



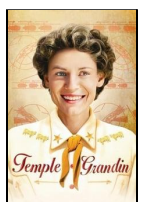
