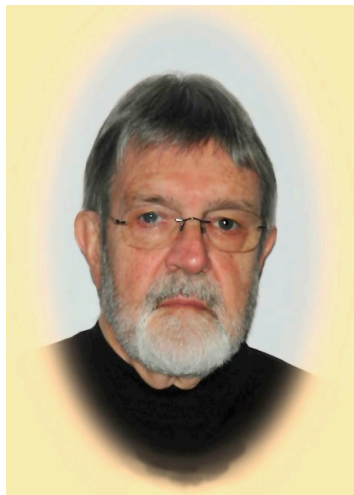

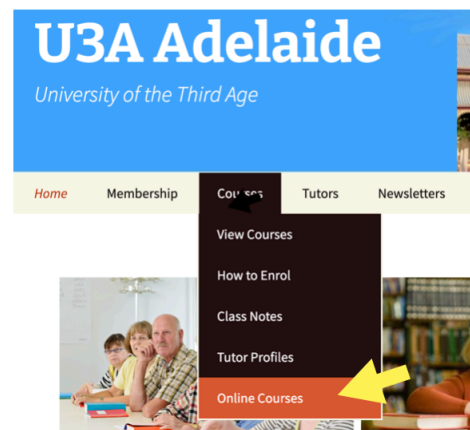
That humour is what I remember most about Tony - he would be quietly listening to a discussion, and would then join in with superbly appropriate, and often irreverent contributions.
